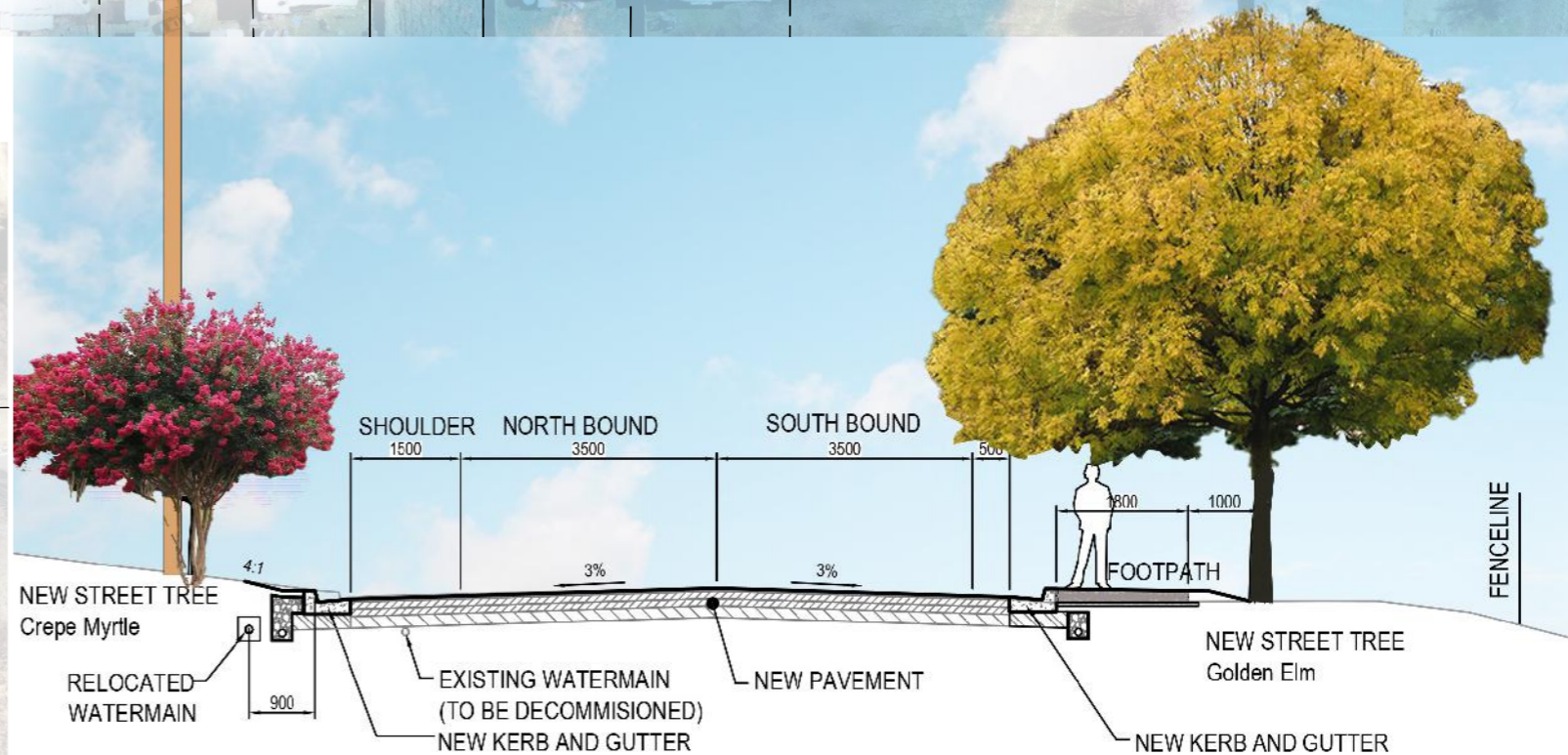

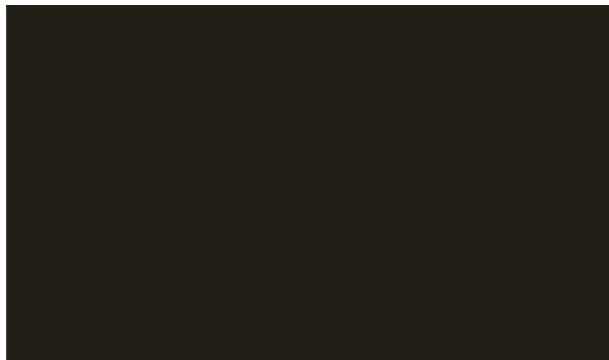
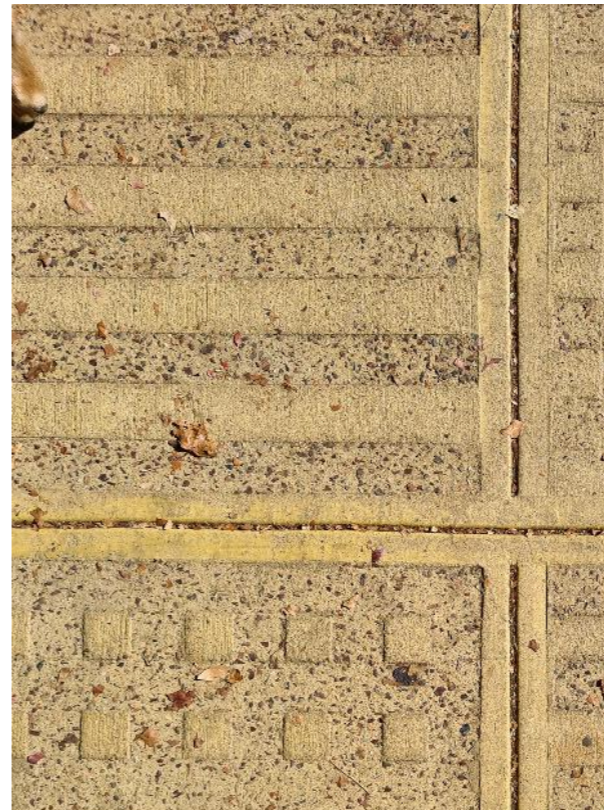
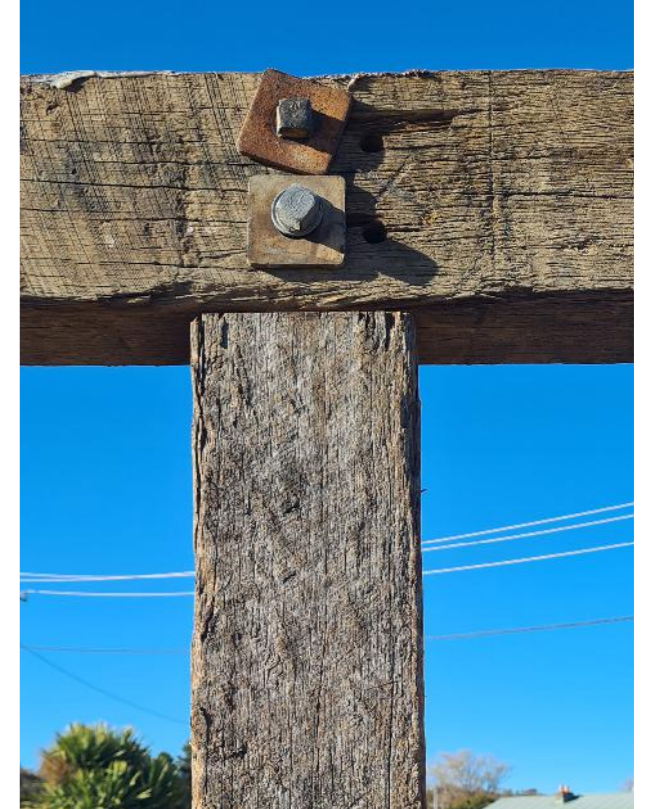
- OBSERVATIONS**
- Entry Sculpture Signs are evocative and dramatic however difficult to read
 - New Sculpture Trail Signage is contemporary and suits Walcha's evolving character
 - Information Signs need updating
 - Monument Park monuments are high above the street and concealed against the trees
 - Most parks have no signage
 - Existing Park signage is fragmented and dated
 - Showground frontage is bare with agricultural buildings and rusted chainmesh fence with barbed wire to the top
 - There is no sign that says Walcha Showground
 - Most of the signage is Transport for NSW standard signage
 - Road carriageway is expansive
 - Street trees on Western side are small to not interfere with powerlines
