
### Q2 Where do you normally live?




### Q3 Did you travel to Walcha specifically to attend the event?




### Q4 How many nights in total did you spend in Walcha on this trip?






### Q10 While attending the event, did you make use of the free Town Loop Shuttle Bus?




### Q11 Was this your first visit to Walcha
